

How to get to Coimbra

Fly to Lisboa (to the South) or to Porto (to the North) and then take transportation to Coimbra.

From Lisboa to Coimbra:

By train:

If you are at the airport, take a taxi to "Gare do Oriente" train station.

If you are at the city centre, take a taxi to "Santa Apolónia" train station.

Buy a ticket to either "Intercidades" or "Alfa Pendular" trains. You can check schedules and buy tickets on the Internet at http://www.cp.pt/cp/displayPage.do?vgnextoid=87cbd5abe2a74010VgnVCM1000007b01a8c0RCRD&lang=en

Step out of the train in "Coimbra B".

Take a taxi to your hotel.

By car:

Take the highway A1 (Autoestrada A1-Norte) towards Porto.

After around 200Km take the exit "Coimbra-Sul" to arrive at the city center.

Travel time: around 2H00.

Toll costs: € 11,75.

From Porto to Coimbra:

By train:

Take a taxi to the train station "Porto-Campanhã".

Buy a ticket to either "Intercidades" or "Alfa Pendular" trains. You can check schedules and buy tickets on the Internet at http://www.cp.pt/cp/displayPage.do?vgnextoid=87cbd5abe2a74010VgnVCM1000007b01a8c0RCRD&lang=en

Step out of the train in "Coimbra B".

Take a taxi to your hotel.

By car

Take the highway A1 (Autoestrada A1-Norte) towards Lisboa.

After around 110Km take the exit "Coimbra-Sul" to arrive at the city center.

Travel time: around 1H10.

Toll costs: € 6,00.
